ATTORNEY JIM DUNN APPOINTED TO VT LABOR RELATIONS BOARD

BURLINGTON, VT - Jim Dunn has been appointed to serve on the Vermont Labor Relations Board. Dunn's appointment by Governor Douglas to the six-member board that governs labor relations for public sector employers, employees and small private operations, is effective immediately.

A graduate of Williams College and Suffolk Law School, Dunn began his practice in Vermont in 1974 with Vermont Legal Aid. He was an original founder of the law firm currently known as Mickenberg, Dunn, Kochman, Lachs & Smith, and beginning in 1982, was Chief Labor Negotiator for the city of Burlington for a ten year span. He also served as Personnel Director for the City of Burlington in the mid-1980s.

Since 1991, Dunn has represented union clients in both the municipal and private sector, including police and fire unions throughout Vermont. In addition to collective bargaining, contract administration, grievance and arbitration proceedings, Dunn has served as mediator and arbitrator in labor and personal injury cases.
